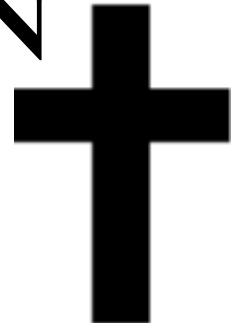

World Day of Prayer- This service was held on Friday 4th March and enjoyed by everyone who attended, The offering totalled £155.50. Thank you to everyone who participated and for the fellowship after the service.
